The auctions were previously held on Friday night and Saturday afternoon. This change was made to accommodate auction buyers and sellers by allowing them the opportunity to enjoy all of the automotive excitement happening on the Carlisle PA Fairgrounds during the day and also to add to the excitement and atmosphere that comes with an evening auction.
